


NAYA KSHITIJ: NEP 2020 TEACHERS' TRAINING WORKSHOP FOR SCHOOL TEACHERS

After the successful organization of a half-day Webinar on the 'New Education Policy' (NEP), 2020 for schools and its implementation in Rajasthan schools which was attended and appreciated by more than 484 teachers, principals, and administrators from government, private, and English medium schools of Rajasthan, The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) BITS Pilani, Pilani Campus is organizing a short-term teachers' training programme for school teachers. The proposed training programme aims at equipping the teachers with the tools, techniques and approaches for effective teaching. The key feature of this training will include the hands-on practice after a short lecture. Since the teachers will be playing a very crucial role in the effective implementation of NEP 2020, it becomes imperative that teachers develop ease at using technology for teaching, classroom management, and assessment.

The 10 hours training will be imparted to empower the school teachers in the following Key Areas of the NEP 2020:

- 1. Online teaching and learning: Etiquette, preparation, and practice
- 2. Use of tools and techniques for effective teaching
- 3. Inquiry-based teaching for developing critical and creative thinking
- 4. Positive classroom environment: teacher-student relationship
- 5. Academic Leadership

All sessions will be conducted with hands-on practice or active participation.
