

Lab Instructions

- Students should be punctual in coming to the lab.
- Please follow the lab timetable according to your lab section number.
- Please bring your lab manual when you come to the laboratory.
- It is recommended to bring your own pen, pencil, eraser, scale, etc., instead of asking your friends in the lab.
- Students are to wear safety glasses whenever necessary before performing an experiment.
- Please do not speak louder/shout in lab corridors and in lab rooms; it may cause disturbance to nearby classes.
- Keep your bags in designated cupboards, do not keep bags at exit doors.
- Please read about procedures and precautions before performing any experiment.
- Do not play with or deface any apparatus; if you observe any breakage, you must inform your instructor in the lab.
- For any assistance, please communicate with the lab faculty (or) lab instructor.
- Do not lean or sit on experiment tables in the lab; use lab chairs/stools to sit.
- Do not put pens/pencils/scales/fingers in AC electrical sockets or in voltage outputs. It may cause electrical shock to you.
- Dump waste papers/pencil dust/tissue papers in dustbins. Do not litter the lab rooms.
- Please switch off the setup when you complete your experiment.
- Before leaving the lab, you must hand over the apparatus and associated instruments to the lab faculty.
- Students should not take any apparatus / any accessory / any lab item / any lab manual book, out of the lab room.
- You are not permitted to leave the laboratory until the completion of laboratory class hours. In case of any emergency/assistance, please coordinate with your lab instructor.
